**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDING FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT  
CENTRAL AVENUE AND INSTALLATION OF ADA RAMPS FOR THE  
BOROUGH OF HILLSDALE AND APPROPRIATING \$421,500 FOR SUCH  
PURPOSE.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HILLSDALE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Borough of Hillsdale, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough"), authorizes improvements at Central Avenue, including construction, inspection, testing, certification and all work or materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto for the Borough to be funded from the sources specified in Section 2 of the Ordinance.

Section 2. The amount of \$211,500 is hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in Section 1 of the Ordinance (of which \$195,000 is for construction and \$16,500 is for the remaining costs) and which amount was funded from a grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation in the amount of \$211,500.

Section 3. The Borough authorize the installation of ADA ramps at various locations in the Borough, including the construction, inspection, certification and all work or materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto for the Borough to be funded from the sources specified in Section 4 of this Ordinance.

Section 4. The amount of \$210,000 is hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in Section 3 of the Ordinance (of which \$175,000 is for construction and \$35,000 is for the remaining costs) and which amount was funded from a grant from the County of Bergen, New Jersey in the amount of \$210,000.


Section 5. In connection with the purpose and the amount authorized in Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 hereof, the Borough determines the purposes described in Section 1 and 3 hereof is not a Current Expense and is an improvement which the Borough may lawfully make as a general improvement.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.


Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon due passage and publication according to law.
