**Health Officer and Employee Reports:**

A. NWBRHC reports: (see attached)

1. Lead abatement: A Musella reported lead case testing came back negative. A letter will be sent to the building department for a final Certificate of Occupancy.
2. Vaccines ordered for CHC and have been received.
3. 5 complaints have been received by NWBRHC mostly in reference to animals. Carol Tyler from

has spoken to Bob Sandt regarding an ordinance for limiting the amount of animals per household. This will be referred to M. Hanlon to follow up on.

4. Public Health Educator, Dawn Schneider will speak at the 50+ club in July, the topic will be nutrition.
  5. B. Martine said she is not aware of some of the complaints that come in. S. Jeune will forward any pertinent complaints on to her.
- B. Registrar reports: see attached, D. Kohan is continuing as our registrar and has submitted all necessary State reports.
- C. L. Kohan is continuing with home visits and also with continuing education, webinars, classes and meetings with B. Martine.
- D. 1. B. Martine said hearing screening is scheduled at Hillsdale House in February.  
2. January 13<sup>th</sup> CHC clinic was attended by 9 children, 8 from out of town, but said that she would probably have more in April and May.  
3. At the American Legion on February 7<sup>th</sup> B. Martine took blood pressure tests for 12 people.  
4. B. Martine visited St. John's Parish Center which will be the location for the Health Fair. St. John's

is

letting us use their facility at no cost. 8 people so far have signed up for Health Fair.

5. Cheer and Chore Program – retired workers help people with different chores around home, and errands, etc. They will be at the Health Fair.
6. M. Hanlon has put together packets for T. Jeffery from the Code Office to hand out to people when she goes to their homes on property maintenance issues. These packages will have information on resources available to them.
