Health officer and Employee Reports:

A. NWBRHC reports: (see attached)

1. Inspections were done at various food establishments by NWBRHC, all were satisfactory with the exception of Need A Little Snack at Stonybrook swim club. Another inspection was done in August and the owner agreed to have her employee attend a food handler course.
2. Two complaints have been made about residents with standing water in And around their yards. All the people who complained are concerned about West Nile Virus. One of these complaints has been abated so far.
3. Boiling Springs Bank complained that there was a faint odor of what could be sewage gas. An inspection was conducted by NWBRHC. The bank had
a plumber check the building and nothing was found. Air samples were taken and are being analyzed.
4. G. Brunner did not have the new contract for NWBRHC.

B. 1. S. Jeune gave the registrars report.

C. 1. B. Martine has been approached by “Home Instead” which is a senior care center. They do a lot for seniors including driving them to appointments, shopping, etc. They do not accept Medicare so seniors would have to pay.
