Title: Interlocal Agreement with the Borough of Paramus for 9-1-1 Service

WHEREAS, the Borough of Hillsdale seeks to utilize the services of the Borough of Paramus to provide Public Answering Point (PSAP) emergency 9-1-1 service; and

WHEREAS, each of the parties hereto are authorized by law to enter into an agreement with another Municipality to provide jointly for any lawful service to and for the residents of the respective Municipalities pursuant to the provisions of the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.; and





NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Hillsdale hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Borough of Paramus for 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone Services for 2012 at a cost of \$5,253.50.
