CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HILLSDALE AUTHORIZING THE 2011 ROAD, CURB, SIDEWALK AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH, APPROPRIATING THEREFORE THE SUM OF \$305,000 AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM A NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT AND FROM THE BOROUGH'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Hillsdale, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Hillsdale, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the 2011 Road, Curb, Sidewalk and Drainage Improvement Program in, by and for the Borough, as set forth on a list prepared or to be prepared by the Borough Engineer on file or to be placed on file with the Borough Clerk, and hereby approved as if set forth herein in full. Depending upon the contract price and other exigent circumstances, and upon approval by the Borough Council, there may be additions to or deletions from the above-referenced list. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$305,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from a New Jersey Department of Transportation ("NJDOT") grant for resurfacing of Ralph Avenue and from the Borough's Capital Improvement Fund, as hereinafter provided. The sum of \$150,000 received or to be received from the NJDOT is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the Ralph Avenue resurfacing component of said purpose. The sum of \$155,000 is hereby appropriated from the

Borough's Capital Improvement Fund to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. Said improvements are lawful capital improvements of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
