**AMENDING CHAPTER 212, OUTDOOR CAFES AND CHAPTER 138,  
FEES OF THE CODE BOOK OF THE BOROUGH OF HILLSDALE**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Code Sections pertaining to outdoor dining have been reviewed by the governing body; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to amend those sections for the Borough of Hillsdale;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Hillsdale, in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that the following Borough Code revisions be made and are hereby adopted:

**SECTION 1:**

**Hillsdale Borough Code Section 212-3. License Required**, shall be amended with additional language (indicated by underlining) as follows:

“It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, corporation, association or organization of any kind (hereinafter collectively referred to as "person") to create, establish, operate, maintain or otherwise be engaged in the business of conducting an outdoor cafe upon the sidewalks of the Borough of Hillsdale without Hillsdale Borough license.”

**SECTION 2:**

**Hillsdale Borough Code Section 212-14. Cleaning of Areas**, shall be amended by retaining the existing section and adding the following at the end of the existing language:

“All garbage generated and left within twenty (20) feet of an outdoor cafe or mobile retail establishment must be removed from the sidewalk and adjoining gutter daily.

Sidewalks shall be steam cleaned whenever necessary and at a minimum frequency of once every three months with cleaning agent and disinfectant.

Garbage and recycling must be removed from the sidewalk prior to opening the outdoor cafe or mobile retail establishment daily and must be kept clear from the sidewalk while food is present outside the establishment. Borough garbage cans must be emptied by the licensee on days that the Borough garbage cans are not picked up or at any time conditions require them to be emptied.

Violation of any of the above cleaning requirements constitutes grounds for revocation or suspension of license to operate within the Borough of Hillsdale with penalty pursuant to section 12 of this chapter.
