**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF COMPETITIVE  
CONTRACTING FOR THE SELECTION OF PROFESSIONAL  
AND/OR OTHER SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, PL 1999 c440 amended the Local Public Contracts Law and created a new category of contracting called Competitive Contracting; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.3(a) requires that in order to initiate competitive contracting, the governing body shall pass a resolution authorizing the use of competitive contracting each time specialized goods and services enumerated in 40A-4.1 are desired to be contracted; and


**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.3(b) requires that the competitive contracting process shall be administered by a purchasing agent qualified pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-9, or by legal counsel of the contracting unit, or by an administrator of the contracting unit.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough Administrator be and is hereby authorized to initiate competitive contracting for the Professional and Other Services listed:

- The operation, management, administration of data processing services
- Maintenance, custodial, and groundskeeping services
- Consulting services
- Grant Writing Services
