Pumps:

Patty explained that the new pumps are installed and the main pool has to have an extension of wiring. This will be completed tomorrow. Slide pump motor has been replaced.

Dome:

Commission spoke about the money need to move forward \$160,000 - \$130,000 in which includes water line, insulation, generator, paving and lights and winter user will pay for the Dome construction, maintenance, salaries, utilities, chemicals, snow plowing. Bo compiled a list with a breakdown of who is responsible for what. This was reviewed. The RFP needs to be worked on. This will be discussed further in the July meeting. The next council meeting is July 5th it takes 2 months to move forward with a vote form council. Bo will take a look at the RFQ.
