**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO WRITE A LETTER TO THE
NEW JERSEY FIRST REVIEW COMMITTEE – STATE OF NEW JERSEY
DEPARTMENT OF LABOR & WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD TO
ALLOW KATHY ELGERT TO CONTINUE AS WELFARE DIRECTOR
DESPITE MOVING OUT OF STATE.**

WHEREAS, Katherine Elgert (hereafter “Elgert”) is an employee of the Borough of Hillsdale in the position of Welfare Director, pursuant to a Shared Service Agreement with the Borough of Westwood; and

WHEREAS, State law requires Borough employees to reside in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, due to a family issue, Elgert recently moved to the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, Elgert is currently appealing the mandate that she live in New Jersey in order to continue in her position; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to retain Elgert in her position as Welfare Director, despite residing out of state, through the end of her contract period, which expires December 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hillsdale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey hereby authorizes Mayor John Ruocco to write a letter on Elgert’s behalf suggesting she be allowed to retain her position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hillsdale, Bergen County, New Jersey, that Mayor John Ruocco is hereby authorized to write a letter in support of Elgert’s retaining her position, as described above.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
