



# 2020 Hillsdale Leaf Program

Vegetative Waste Pick Up will end on October 27th

Leaf Collection will begin approximately October 27<sup>th</sup> (subject to weather conditions).  
(Please **DO NOT** place leaves at the curb before October 19<sup>th</sup> due to DEP regulations)

Leaf Collection will be divided into two sections for the 2020 leaf collection program.  
**One crew will start on Broadway heading east and the other crew will start on Broadway heading west. This will be repeated until the leaves have been picked up or December 7<sup>th</sup>.**

**Leaf collection on primary roads will be completed with the leaf vacuum. This crew will continually go through the town.**

To better serve you, the following is needed to facilitate the pick-up of leaves.....

- NO BAGS, GARBAGE CANS OR BOXES OF ANY KIND will be collected
- Pile leaves neatly at the curb so as NOT to obstruct traffic in the street
- Do NOT mix debris with leaves such as rocks, wood, branches, twigs, etc.
- Leaves should NOT be piled around fire hydrants, light poles, signs, trees, etc.
- Leaves should NOT be placed closer than 15 feet to a stop sign
- \*DO NOT place leaves within ten (10) feet of either side of a storm drain or on top of it
- \*DO NOT place leaves at the curb for more than seven (7) days prior to their scheduled collection date
- Vehicles parked in the street prevent us from working along the curb and collecting your leaves
- The DPW is NOT responsible for any damage to basketball backboards that are located at the curb
- Leaves MUST be at the curb by **December 7<sup>th</sup>** (subject to weather conditions). Any leaves left at the curb beyond this date is in violation of Borough Ordinance 06-10 and you will be subject to a fine
- **If you have a landscape contractor please inform them of the above-mentioned items**

\*Stormwater Regulations are imposed by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection

~You may place mesh or burlap between the curb and the leaves to keep them from blowing back on the lawn. Mesh or burlap is available at garden supply and hardware stores~

***Leaves that are placed into the street that contain branches or bushes will not be picked up. Summons may be issued. Branches are to be delivered to the Recycling Center for disposal.***
