MINUTES OF APRIL 3, 2014

The Hillsdale Recreation Commission held its regular meeting on April 3, 2014 with John Corring, Ann Cron, Bob Darcey, Gerard Dargan, John Noone, Andrew Puller, Patty Hughes, and Councilwoman Looes in attendance.

Absent from the meeting were Dawn Timpanaro, Matt Hausch, and Alyssa Zoll.

Chairman John Corring called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

The minutes of March 6, 2014 were approved (Cron/Dargan)

New Business

AED (automated external defibrillator) – currently there are none on fields or in the fieldhouses. There should be one at every field, for a total of six. Each one costs about \$800. Discussed who would pay for it, storage, maintenance, and training. There may be grant money available and the sports associations could also contribute. There would be no insurance savings. The NJ statute regarding AEDs was shown to the commissioners.

ID Pictures for Coaches – will have photo ids for every coach by the end of summer which will be good for three years.

Camp Discovery – new name for kindergarten camp which will be held at Pascack Bible Church for three weeks, July 14 – August 1, from 9:00am to 2:00pm. Anna will be new director.

Parent Code of Conduct – Patty showed the commissioners the one that is used by the soccer association, which will now be used for all recreation programs. It will be put on the website for parents to accept before registering child(ren) for programs.

CPR Training for Coaches – Patty will look into setting up something with Hillsdale Ambulance Corps and the county for the coaches to attend free of charge.

Easter Egg Hunt – will be held on April 12, 9:00am at Beechwood. If it rains, it will be held at While School.

Senior Luncheon – April 23 at St. Johns

Safety Meeting- spoke about epi pens and who should administer them. They need to be refrigerated. Patty will research who should administer them.

Senior Trip Budget – since senior trip budget was cut, they are looking into new ways to save money, such as possible combining with other towns. Hunterdon Hills Playhouse is a new place to go. Trips will be open to all seniors, not just those who are members of the 55+ Club.
