HILLSDALE RECREATION COMMISSION
MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 7, 2013

The Hillsdale Recreation commission held its regular meeting on February 7, 2013 with John Corring, Ann Cron, Bob Darcey, Rich Gazzillo, Andrew Puller, Peter Scandariato, Matt Hausch, Alyssa Zoll, Patty Hughes, and Tom Kelley in attendance.

Absent from the meeting was Dawn Timpanaro.

Chairman Peter Scandariato called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

Topics for Presentation/Discussion

Budget – salaries and fee ordinances were discussed. Current fees do not cover expenses; therefore an increase in fees is necessary. Proposed 2013 fee increases are as follows:

Men's basketball – from \$65 to \$75
Indoor soccer – from \$35 to \$50
Youth basketball (2nd grade) – from \$45 to \$50
Youth basketball ((3rd -10th grade, 1 child – from \$65 to \$75
Youth basketball (3rd -10th grade, 2+ children) – from \$60 to \$70
Women's volleyball – from \$32 to \$65
Girl's volleyball clinic – from \$32 to \$45
Men's 35+ softball – from \$45 to \$55 (non residents)
Women's 18+ softball – from \$45 to \$60
PV Junior wrestling – from \$95 to \$100
Rutgers coaches clinic – from \$40 to \$45
Art program – from \$75 to \$95
Camp Pascack – from \$685 to \$785
Camp Adventure – from \$735 to \$835
Field trip camp – from \$785 to \$885
Late fee – from \$20 to \$25

A motion was made by Ann Cron and seconded by rich Gazzillo to give proposed fee ordinance, with the exception of men's 18+ softball, to mayor and council for approval. Motion passed unanimously.

Salary Ordinance – proposed increase of 25 cents per hour for HS sophomores, juniors, seniors, and college freshmen who work at camp. Increases proposed for specialists and camp directors. Also increases of between 15 and 45 cents per hour for additional certifications earned.

Secretary will increase from \$3,000 to \$13,000 because will become a 12 month position from a 3 month position. Summer concert coordinator salary removed. There are approximately 320 kids in camp and roughly 40 counselors.

A motion was made by John Corring and seconded by Ann Cron to give proposed salary ordinance to mayor and council for approval. Motion passed with one dissenting vote.

New Business

A letter was sent to sports associations regarding insurance. The borough wants the individual sports associations to pay for accident insurance. Tom Kelly stated that he had not heard about this insurance issue at the council level. He will ask Jonathan DeJoseph for answers and numbers.

Liaison to Mayor and Council

Tom Kelly stated that the council is currently working on the budget.

Remarks from Citizens

Louis Rosenblatt, a resident, addressed the commission. He wanted to rent baseball fields for use by Clemente Baseball. Commissioners informed him that they do not rent fields. Advised him to go to a HBSA meeting and maybe they would sponsor the camp.

Abby Lundy, president of HBSA, wanted approval from Keith Durie to have opening day on March 30 instead of April 1. Tom Kelly will look into this.

Jim Moldow, a resident, addressed commission regarding A League of Our Own permit. He was told that the permit could not be approved because there is an ordinance that prohibits play at Centennial field on Sunday mornings from 9-12. The commissioners suggested that he contact the high school for field availability on Sunday mornings.

A League of Our Own – Jim Moldow – not approved because of Sunday ordinance

Lacrosse – Ed Beja – approved

Hawks Football – Anthony DeGilio – approved
