MINUTES OF JUNE 7, 2012

The Hillsdale Recreation Commission held its regular meeting on June 7, 2012 with Ann Cron, Rich Gazzillo, Andrew Puller, Peter Scandariato, Dawn Timpanaro, Patty Hughes, and Anthony DeRosa in attendance

Absent from the meeting were Bob Darcey, Michael Holmes, and Sara Petro.

Chairman Peter Scandariato called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

Topics for Presentation/Discussion

Rutgers Safety Clinic – will be held on August 15th. Cost is \$35/person

Concerts in Veterans Park – 3 are set, July 11, 18, 25, and possibly August 1. Two donations were received and one verbal from Care One. \$100 donation received from Demarest Farms. Application filed with TDBank for donation.

Payroll – all kids employed with the camp and the pool will have to go to Boro Hall with ID in order to receive their paychecks. Paychecks will be handed out on one day.

Port-A-John – placed at George White will be moved closer to 7-Eleven because of complaints from nearby homeowner. In the future, it will be there from April 1 – November 15, weather permitting. A lock will be placed on it and it will be anchored to the ground. Cost is \$49.50/month to rent. A key will be given to coordinators in each association and will be returned at end of season.

Insurance policy – there have been numerous emails regarding an insurance claim and whether or not the association involved should pay the insurance deductible for the injury. A motion was made by Ann Cron and seconded by Rich Gazzillo to adopt a policy that the sports associations should be responsible for any insurance deductibles. Motion was approved.

New Business

Softball & Water Volleyball Fund Raiser – cost is \$100/team for softball and \$10/head for water volleyball. Half of the proceeds would go to Parkinson's disease research and half would go to the Recreation Commission. Patty will investigate insurance needs and email all commissioners.

Memorial Day Parade – Ann Cron reported that parade and judging was fine. However ice cream came late and parents started grabbing ice cream out of coolers. Suggestion that next water be handed out instead of ice cream
