Health Officer and Employee Reports: (copies of reports are attached)

1. A. Musella: NWBRHC continues to make regular inspections. No complaints, animal bites or food classes were reported. NWBRHC has a new health educator. Various correspondence from the DEP regarding various tanks that were removed. Received reports and information from C. Statile regarding Centennial Field. The field is checked twice annually for ground water and wells and quarterly for gas. There is also a quarterly check for the field monitors. A. Musella feels its being well monitored. The toxic dump sites were discussed. The responsibility of local businesses and recycling was discussed. It's the business owners responsibility to supply recycle bins.

2. M.Deppert: (See report) CHC was held on 3/22. Passed state audit for the vaccines. Regular blood pressure clinics. Mental Health First Aid training went very well, 24 people attended. A waiting list was needed. Still working on the immunization audits with the schools. Started working the schedule for the free clinics.

3. L. Kohan: Continues to make home visits (See report). Attended a program on women and heart disease. An open house will be held on April 30th for the 25th Anniversary of the food pantry.
