1. A. Musella- June, July, and August regular inspections were conducted. In June there was a complaint that Dunkin Donuts was keeping their door open, they were informed they cannot. Two complaints of residents finding dead rodents on their property. The health officer researched the model noise ordinance at the request of the borough administrator. It was found that a variety of communities have a designated noise control officer. These include health officials, police officers, fire inspectors, and building/ zoning officials. and have adopted the ordinance. Some municipalities have shared services with contracted noise control officer. There were two animal bites also in June. In July there was a complaint about animal neglect and property maintenance. Three complaints about no air conditioning in Walgreens and Friendly's. Complaints from residents regarding the smell from Waste Management. Health inspector feels there is an intermittent distinctive garbage odor. Health Officer and Health Inspector both feel the complaint should be forwarded to Bergen County Health Dept which

enforces air pollution regulations for Bergen County. Complaint received regarding AFC Urgent Care. Complainant was referred to NJ Office of the Attorney General. August- A borough hall employee observed rats at a residence on Piermont Ave. Complaint about Groomington Coat Factory. The caller stated she believed her dog became ill after being groomed there. Complaint of roaches seen at Wendy's and La Morentita.
