



- D. Ohme inquired if there is going to be anything done about the deer population. D. Mandeville said the state approved bow hunting in Saddle River. Sterilization is very costly and will not be effective because the deer are multiplying at a greater rate and at younger ages.
2. M. Deppert gave the March report.
    - M. Deppert explained vaccination requirements for schools. School districts Pre-K and K through 12 are required to have a 90% and 95% vaccination rate respectively.

Deppert will email the registration forms to the school nurses and reach out to the special services counselors/teachers.
