As of now, membership is \$229,656.10; last year, we were at \$200,027.10. The ratio of resident to non-resident members is still the same, with 120 resident families and 215 non-resident families registered through CommunityPass.

Director's Report

Patty sent an email blast out about the swim team, including the packet of information and photos of the new bathing suits. Bonding and Grounding has been completed and Stonybrook is all set for the next five years. The CO2 installation has been completed as well.

The Competition Pool is filled and running almost ready for the swim team spring contract. The Main, Diving, and Kiddy Pools are all cleaned and ready to go. The pumps need to be hooked up, but they are finishing the electrical project. Once completed, they can start filling these pools. In addition, the Kiddy pool pump and filter will arrive early next week.

All the water is on in the facility, and there are some repairs being tended to. In addition, the landscaping has been upgraded in areas around the club, including by the snack bar and the competition pool. Patty has also given tours recently and received positive feedback about the pools and facilities.

Previous employees are all set for this year and there is a lot of interest in employment, whether it is as a gate attendant or lifeguard. Patty is working on some new programs, including a game day three days a week from 1-3pm. The games would be Mahjong, checkers, and bingo. Patty also provided flyers about some of the new programs that are being offered, including kids club, a kids menu for the camp kids to take lunch to the park, and this year's spirit wear.

Finally, a discussion was had about the snack bar's readiness for the season.
