 - NWBRHC received 200 vaccines for the March 3, 2021 clinic. Due to the short turnaround time from when they are received and when vaccination must occur, Mahwah hosted the clinic and NWBRHC partnered with HARP (they provide nursing services for Mahwah) Mahwah received 50 doses and each additional town within NWBRHC was allocated 15 doses to provide vaccinations to eligible individuals in the 1A Category- and residents over 75.
