Topics of Discussion

Total Revenue

Total Revenue is \$1,090,000, which is less than last year; however, this total revenue was made in about six months. There were a few factors for the decrease, including no change in membership numbers, less use of programs, no parking lot rental, and a lower cost for the swim team rental.

Membership 2025-2026

Patty explained that membership numbers need to increase year after year. Unfortunately, weather was a factor as to why the membership numbers were consistent with last year. A discussion was held about the membership structure that is used, and whether or not making any changes to said structure, such as a three-tier system, would increase this portion of Stonybrook's revenue.

Director's Report

At last night's council meeting, they finalized the resolution to replace all of the chlorine controllers and stenner pumps in both pump houses. These replacements will be completed over the winter.

The last event is a rummage sale and fliers were put up in town today to advertise this event.
