Topics of Discussion

Membership 2025

Membership is off to a good start, and there is an almost 13% increase from last year for a total of \$560,857.20. Last year at this time, membership was \$497,522.80. Overall, revenue is up, totaling \$565,004.20 compared to \$526,087.50 in 2024.

Garrett Rothschild, a longtime employee came by to say thank you and see you later to the commission. He is now working at another swimming club as a director. The commission wished him lots of luck and thanked him for his service.

Director's Report

The CO2 installation is completed, and fire and electrical inspections are done. The CO to open is done, and the Board of Health inspection for opening is pending. In addition, the GFI electrical project is completed, and the pool pumps are up and running. The new Intermediate Pool pump will be installed soon, and the plastering of this pool is completed. The new Kiddy Pool pump and motor are working great. A discussion was held about being proactive about replacing pool equipment.

Additional projects, including the new fence by the snack bar, awning installations, painting the Kiddy Pool fence, and waxing the slide will be completed in the next few weeks. Other painting projects, including the playground, bathrooms, Main Pool Slide stairs and railing, Intermediate Pool stairs and railing, and additional plumbing issues have been completed and repaired. Finally, the shed next to the pavilion will be fixed as it houses supplies.

A discussion was held about Patty's additional hours during the Stonybrook preseason, season, and post-season, and keeping track of said hours. As of now, she has over 330 hours in for the last month. Borough full timer must work the 140 hours per month.

Finally, Stonybrook may merge its dive team with another in the area, as there is currently no dive coach. An additional discussion was held about training the new assistant managers.

Other Business

Linda Parisi discussed the banner sponsorships for Stonybrook. As of now, the total revenue is \$1,200 with a projected total of \$2,000.

Chris Camp discussed the website, including fixing broken links. There have been 3,000 visits and a 10% increase in traffic. Most are using it to access registration.

Amelia Bowers created a detailed survey for members to fill out at the end of the season, and a discussion was held about attaching a possible incentive.

The Council Liaison, Justin Fox, is absent, and therefore, there is no report from him.
