**RESOLUTION FOR MEMBER PARTICIPATION
IN A COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF HILLSDALE, NJ
TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5) authorizes a County Government to establish a Cooperative Pricing System for Electricity Generation and Natural Gas Supply Services with voluntary participation available to all local government units (LGUs) within the jurisdiction to purchase goods and services through a centralized County procurement operation; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2012 the governing body of the Borough of Hillsdale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey duly considered participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the provision and performance of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, the BCPS guarantees to reasonably outperform the Basic Generation Service for its members.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

TITLE

This RESOLUTION shall be known and may be cited as the Bergen Cooperative Pricing Resolution of the Borough of Hillsdale

AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5)*, the Borough Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Lead Agency.

CONTRACTING UNIT


The Lead Agency shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of the *Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.)* and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey pursuant to the cooperative procurement of electricity generation and/or natural gas supply services for participating member communities.


EFFECTIVE DATE

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and remain in effect for a period of five (5) years. However, participating members may opt out of the BCPS at the end of any third party supply contract entered into by the lead agency.
