There is a meeting with the town engineer on Monday 2/11... then he will come back in 2-3 weeks with his recommendations regarding the fields. The DPW superintendent Bill Haffler will either be invited to a rec meeting or will attend a separate meeting to discuss the DPWs capabilities around repairing the fields. The commission will bring this information in front of the council sometime in March.

Rec Directors Report

There is a Rutgers course on 2/28. We are currently charging 60 dollars to use our fields. The borough admin would like to raise this cost, however Patty explained that our fields are not in good enough condition to ask for more money. Dewey thinks the problem is less about the cost and more about making sure the money is collected for the field use. Now there will be a module in community pass where people can pre pay for the fields use.

The camp still does not have anywhere to call home base. The camp has been turned down by multiple establishments that Patty has contacted. She will go back to the school superintendent and explain the camp has been in the schools since 1950 and they really need a place. This meeting is to take place on 2/14. Another idea Patty came up with was trailers at beechwood, however this would be very costly.

Patty hands out fliers for the Hillsdale festival to solicit vendors and donations for the event. The event is scheduled for 9/14. Dewey wants the event to make a lot of money that can be used to future events.

For the senior program there was no grant money for senior lunches now they have a grant for cultural experience.
